Viña Cartín was founded in the Salnés Valley in 1977. In 2003, Viña Cartín opened up new facilities, changing its location to an old winery, refurbished with the utmost respect and seeking the combination of its traditional character with new technologies and winemaking methods. Our own vineyards assure us the right quantity and quality of the raw material needed to produce our wines, which are processed with the utmost care and respect from the vineyard to the bottle.

Since its inception, the winery has grown and evolved, changing its facilities to a more functional and technical building, always supporting its tradition, its people, its land and its culture to get the best results.

Winemaking:

Artisanal wine with careful preparation and meticulous selection. Grape selection based on the vineyards age and type of soil. Macerated prior to fermentation at a temperature of 8-12 °C for 12-18 hours in order to get the full extraction of aromas. Fermentation at a controlled temperature of 16°C for 10-15 days. The wine is then stirred together with its own lees in order to achieve the characteristic smoothness and persistence of this wine.
